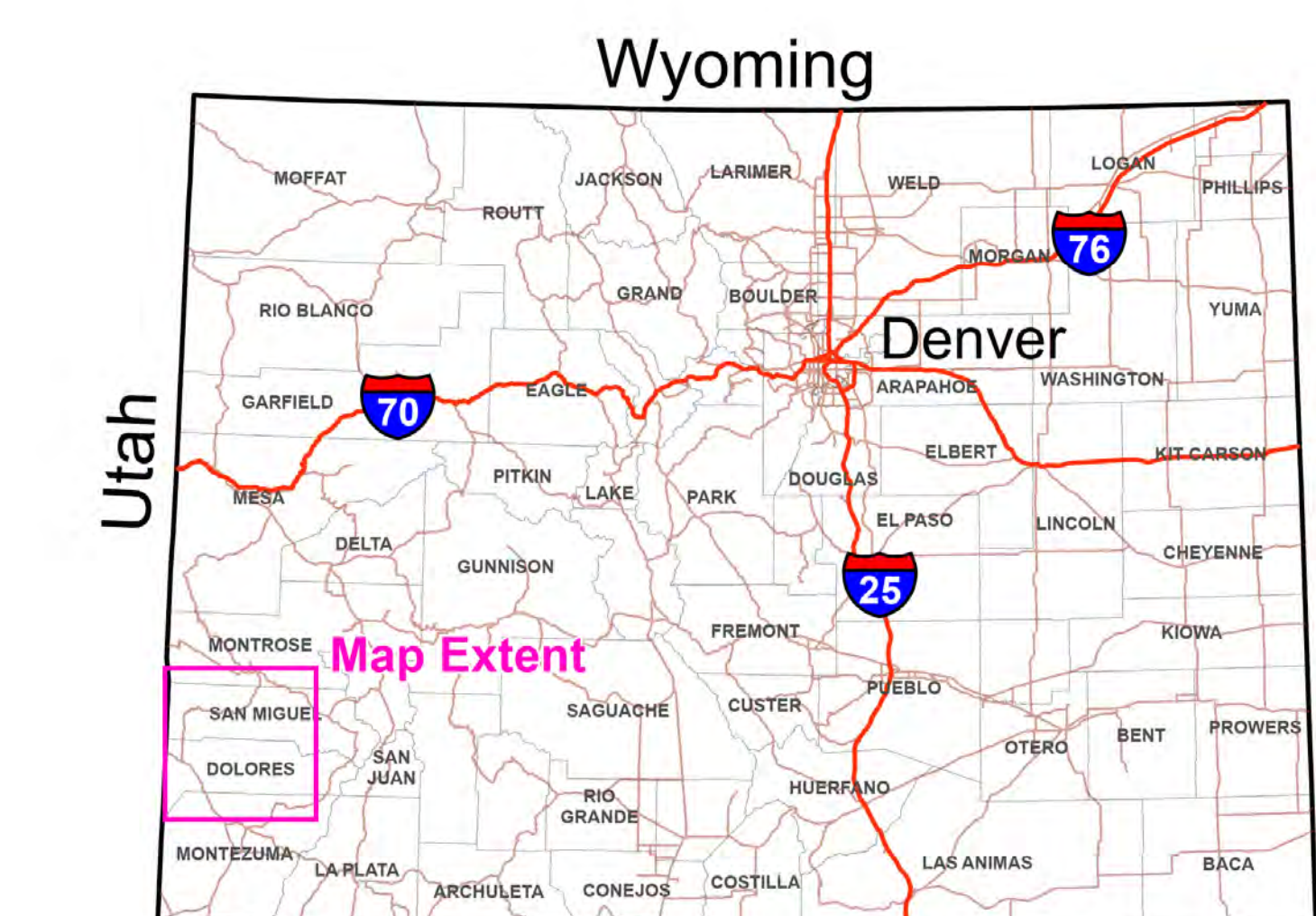
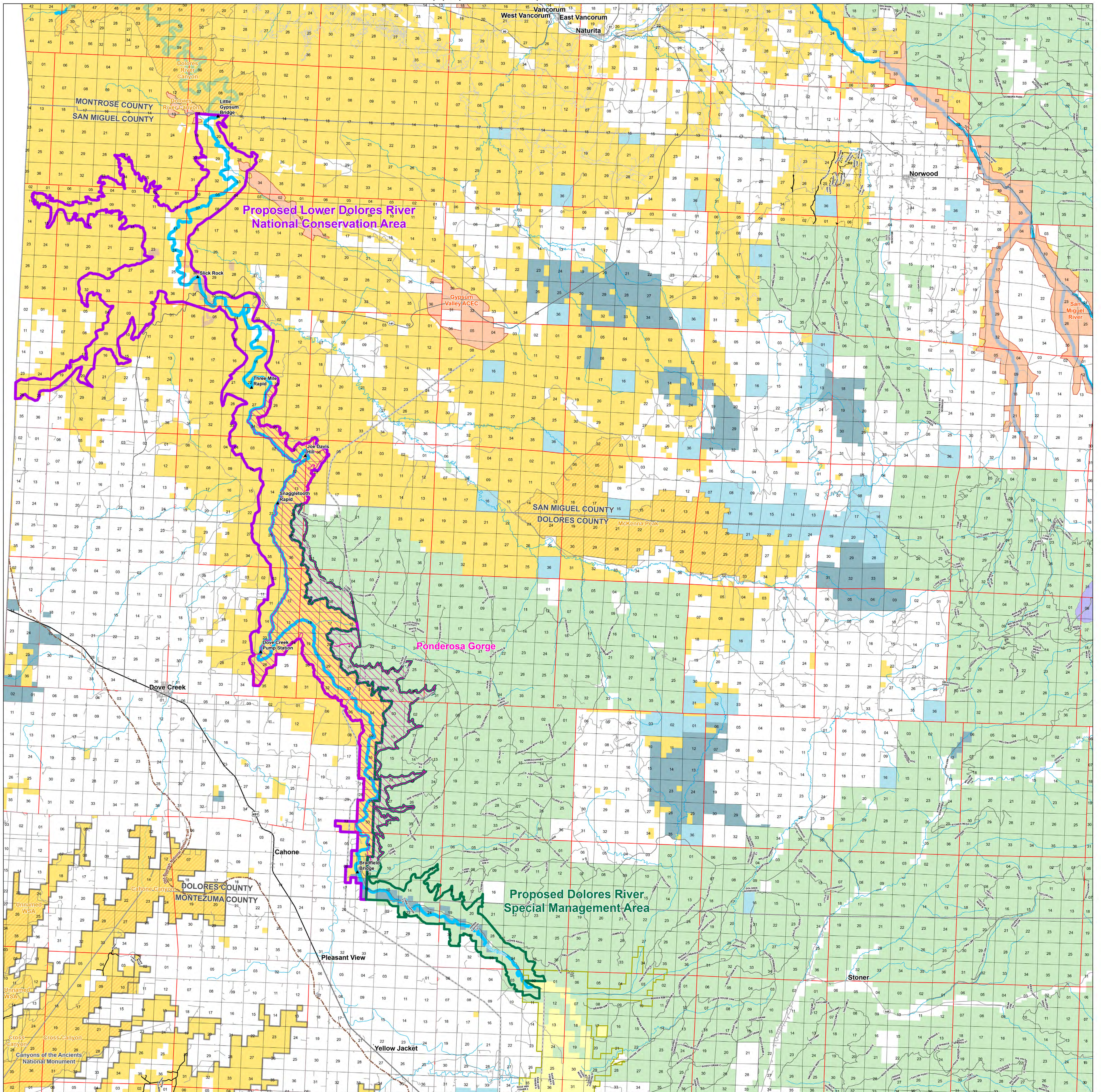


Proposed Dolores River National Conservation Area and Special Management Area
