We write in support of the application submitted by Morgan County, Colorado, in partnership with the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) to the U.S. Department of Transportation for funding from the 2023 Multimodal Project Discretionary Grant (MPDG) program. If selected, Morgan County will improve efficiency, safety, and mobility along one of Colorado's major freight corridors.

Interstate 76 (I-76) is part of the National Freight Highway Network and National Highway System, making it a critical freight route and key economic driver in Colorado. Based on projected population and employment levels, both passenger and freight traffic volumes will continue to increase and affect I-76. MPDG funds will help reconstruct 1.45 miles of concrete pavement; replace four bridges and two concrete box culverts; and convert a partial clover interchange into a tight diamond. In addition, a parkand-ride facility will be installed, from which users may access Fort Morgan, Greeley, Fort Collins, Denver, Sterling, and other communities across the region.

I-76 is critical for freight transport, tourism, recreation, and access to natural resources for economic livelihood.
